**FEAST OF THE IMMACULATE CONCEPTION
OBLIGATION TRANSFERRED TO DECEMBER 9**

The Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary (Dec. 8) is a holy day in the U.S. because it is under this title that the Mother of the Lord is our patroness -- it is now always a holy day of obligation. This year, December 8 is the Second Sunday of Advent, and so has liturgical preference over the Immaculate Conception. Because of the significance of this Marian feast, its observance is moved this year to Monday, Dec. 9, 2024. And, according to a response from the Holy See to an inquiry from the U.S. bishops, the obligation is also transferred. This is a new interpretation of the church's law. So, Dec. 9, 2024, the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception is now always a holy day of obligation. The Mass Schedule will be as follows:

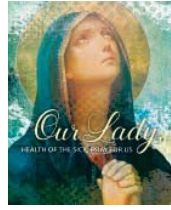

The Blessing of an Advent Wreath

The use of the Advent Wreath is a traditional practice which has found its place in the Church as well as in the home. The blessing of an Advent Wreath takes place on the First Sunday of Advent or on the evening before the First Sunday of Advent. When the blessing of the Advent Wreath is celebrated in the home, it is appropriate that it be blessed by a parent or another member of the family.

All make the sign of the cross

Leader: Our help is in the name of the Lord.

Response (R/.): Who made heaven and earth.

Reader: Let us listen to the words of the Prophet Isaiah (Isaiah 1-2 and 5-6) (Alternately, Isaiah 63 (lines 16-17 & 19) or Isaiah 64 (lines 2-7) may be used).

The people who walked in darkness have seen a great light; Upon those who dwelt in the land of gloom a light has shone. You have brought them abundant joy and great rejoicing, As they rejoice before you as at the harvest, as men make merry when dividing spoils. For a child is born to us, a son is given us; upon his shoulder dominion rests. They name him Wonder-Counselor, God-Hero, Father-Forever, Prince of Peace. His dominion is vast and forever peaceful, From David's throne, and over his kingdom, which he confirms and sustains By judgment and justice, both now and forever. The zeal of the LORD of hosts will do this!

Reader: The Word of the Lord.

R/. Thanks be to God.

Leader:

Lord our God,
we praise you for your Son, Jesus Christ:
he is Emmanuel, the hope of the peoples,
he is the wisdom that teaches and guides us,
he is the Savior of every nation.
Lord God,
let your blessing come upon us
as we light the candles of this wreath.
May the wreath and its light



be a sign of Christ's promise to bring us salvation.

Dear Parishioners and Friends of Saint Theresa of Avila Parish,

November 17, 2024

I write today to invite your participation in and support of the 2024 Grand Annual Collection. This yearly undertaking is the single most significant means, other than the weekly Offertory Collection, by which we, through your generous commitment, are able to raise the funds necessary to provide compassionate pastoral care, celebrate beautiful and uplifting liturgies, maintain all of the buildings and grounds of our lovely but large campus, and, quite simply, continue to carry out the mission and ministry of Christ Jesus, Our Lord, in collaboration with our neighboring Parish of Saint John Chrysostom and in communion with our recently installed Archbishop Richard Henning and the Archdiocese of Boston, right here in our little corner of West Roxbury.

As we move forward into the New Church Year which begins with the First Sunday of Advent on December 1st and into the New Year of 2025, Father Charlie Higgins, Deacon Brian Kean and I, along with our pastoral staff members and volunteers, look forward to working together with you to build up and strengthen our parish communities. In keeping with the synodal vision of Pope Francis and the enthusiastic welcome of our new Shepherd, Archbishop Henning, we hope to reinvigorate our parish Pastoral and Finance Councils, and we anticipate participating in an Archdiocesan-sponsored opportunity to implement a stewardship and increased offertory campaign to welcome back our many old friends and invite many more new folks to join us in worship, fellowship and service. We want to work towards increasing our numbers of in-person congregants at our Saturday Vigil and Sunday Masses. We, like many parishes in the Archdiocese of Boston, are now only welcoming roughly fifty percent (50%) of the parishioners at weekend Masses as we were pre-pandemic in 2019. With your ongoing support, we very much look forward to building up and strengthening our parish communities. Your continued financial support of Saint Theresa of Avila Parish and in particular this 2024 Grand Annual Collection will allow us to be in a strong position to move forward into a future which we can build together with God's guidance and grace.

Some folks have asked how much money they should contribute to the Grand Annual Collection. As in most situations, there is no "one size fits all" answer. I simply invite each family to prayerfully consider your own ability to make a sacrificial offering. As a guide, considering the demographics of our parish community, I would respectfully ask each working family to contribute a minimum of Five-Hundred Dollars (\$500) to the Grand Annual if your circumstances allow.

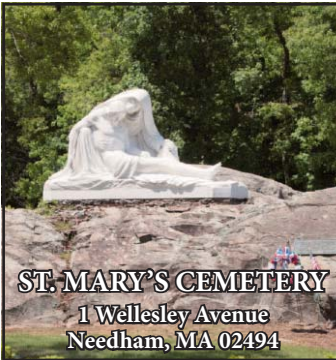

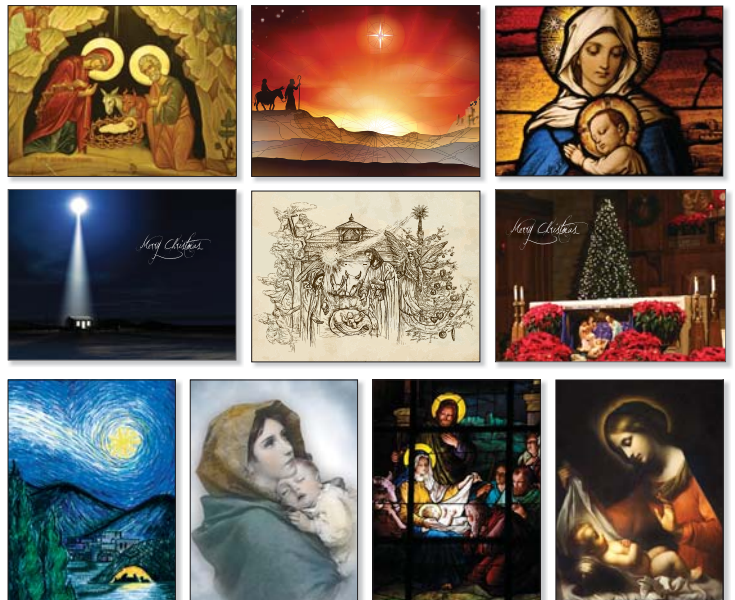
